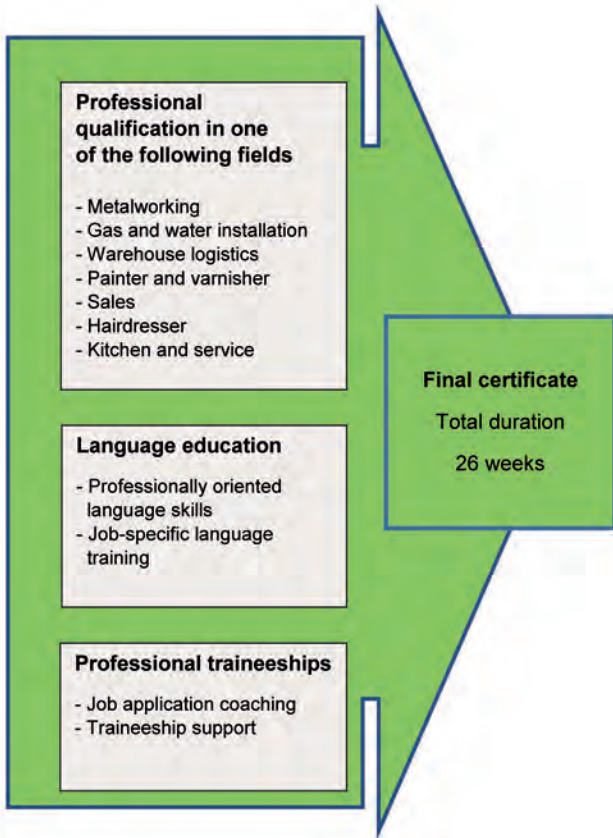

A certificate of participation in the further education program will be issued.



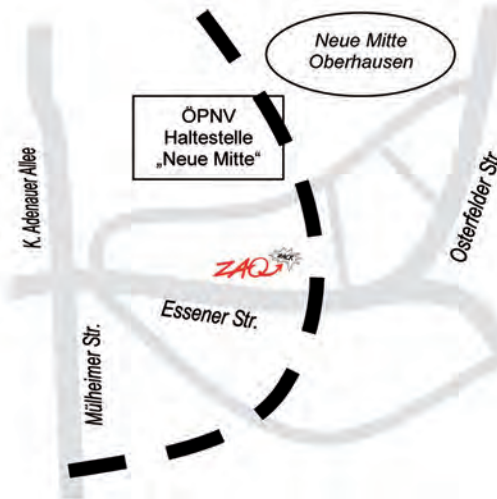

„Professional qualification and professionally oriented language education“

A modular program to support integration in the labor market





Target group

The modular qualification program is designed primarily for refugees and people with a migrant background who want to start vocational training or a job.

Aims of the program

The aims of the qualification program are

- to provide professionally oriented German-language skills
- to improve chances of social integration
- to promote integration into the labor market

Program duration

The qualification program is offered full-time with a duration of 26 weeks.

The courses take place Mondays to Thursdays from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. and Fridays from 7 a.m. to 1.30 p.m. The times, content and organization of the courses take into account the living circumstances of the participants.

Program provider

The Zentrum für Ausbildung und berufliche Qualifikation e.V. (ZAQ) is a recognized and reliable partner for the various stakeholders on the labor market. As an educational institution that is active in networks and cooperative projects and supraregional cooperative projects, the ZAQ provides comprehensive and ongoing services to support processes of individual development and integration into the labor market.

The ZAQ has committed itself to fulfilling the quality specifications laid down by DIN EN ISO 9001:2008 and the "Further Training Approval Ordinance" (AZAV - Akkreditierungs- und Zulassungsverordnung Arbeitsförderung).

Program venue

The qualification program is run at premises of the ZAQ in Oberhausen.

Financing

The qualification program is approved according to §§ 179/180 SGB III. It is eligible for grants with an education voucher.

Education voucher

An education voucher ("Bildungsgutschein") is issued by the employment office ("Agentur für Arbeit" or "Jobcenter"). An education voucher provides assurance that the costs incurred during participation in the further education program will be covered.

Prerequisites for an education voucher

Further vocational training is intended to considerably improve the participants' chances of finding employment on the labor market.

A would-be participant's skill set, previous work history, professional grounding and personal qualifications are all taken into account when considering whether such assistance should be granted.

The employment office or job center use these criteria to assess whether and to what extent the participation in further education measures will contribute to a person's chances of integration and whether funding will be given.
